1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the confidentiality of certain information of and the
1-20 abolishment date of the military base realignment and closure task
1-21 force.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 436.105, Government Code, is amended by
1-24 adding Subsection (c-1) and amending Subsection (d) to read as
1-25 follows:

1-26 (c-1) Any information written, produced, collected,
1-27 assembled, or maintained by or for the task force is confidential
1-28 and exempt from disclosure under Chapter 552 only during the task
1-29 force's existence.

1-30 (d) The task force is abolished and this section expires
1-31 September 1, 2021 [~~2019~~].

1-32 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 436, Government Code, is
1-33 amended by adding Section 436.1051 to read as follows:

1-34 Sec. 436.1051. MILITARY BASE REALIGNMENT AND CLOSURE TASK
1-35 FORCE; PRESERVATION OF INFORMATION. (a) On the abolishment of the
1-36 military base realignment and closure task force, the task force
1-37 shall transfer all information written, produced, collected,
1-38 assembled, or maintained by or for the task force to the commission
1-39 and the commission shall maintain the information.

1-40 (b) Any information transferred to the commission under
1-41 Subsection (a) is public information subject to disclosure under
1-42 Chapter 552.

1-43 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
