AN ACT

1-19 relating to the overseas military e-mail ballot program. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-20 SECTION 1. 1-21 Section 105.004(b), Election Code, is amended to

1-22 1-23 read as follows: (b) The secretary of state shall select to participate in 1-24 the program any county [a number of counties as determined by the 1-25 secretary of state] that:
