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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.9366 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.9366. AMNESTY FOR STUDENTS REPORTING INCIDENTS OF
- 9 SEXUAL ASSAULT. (a) In this section:
- 10 (1) "Coordinating board" means the Texas Higher
- 11 Education Coordinating Board.
- 12 (2) "Postsecondary educational institution" means an
- 13 institution of higher education or a private or independent
- 14 institution of higher education, as those terms are defined by
- 15 Section 61.003.
- 16 (b) A postsecondary educational institution may not take
- 17 any disciplinary action against a student enrolled at the
- 18 <u>institution for a violation by the student of the institution's</u>
- 19 policies on student conduct if the student reports to the
- 20 <u>institution being the victim of, or a witness to, an incident of</u>
- 21 sexual assault and the violation of the institution's policies is
- 22 <u>in relation to the incident. This subsection applies regardless of</u>
- 23 the location at which the incident occurred or the outcome of the
- 24 institution's disciplinary process or a criminal proceeding

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- 1 regarding the incident, if any.
- 2 (c) This section may not be construed to limit a
- 3 postsecondary educational institution's ability to provide amnesty
- 4 from application of the institution's policies in circumstances not
- 5 described by Subsection (b).
- 6 (d) The coordinating board may adopt rules as necessary to
- 7 <u>implement and enforce this section.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 51.9366, Education Code, as added by
- 9 this Act, applies beginning with the 2017-2018 academic year.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
