1-19 relating to vehicles exempt from vehicle safety inspections.
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 548.052, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-22 to read as follows:
 1-23 Sec. 548.052. VEHICLES NOT SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. This
 1-24 chapter does not apply to:
 1-25 (1) a trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or mobile
 1-26 home moving under or bearing a current factory-delivery license
 1-27 plate or current in-transit license plate;
 1-28 (2) a vehicle moving under or bearing a paper dealer
 1-29 in-transit tag, machinery license, disaster license, parade
 1-30 license, prorated tab, one-trip permit, vehicle temporary transit
 1-31 permit, antique license, custom vehicle license, street rod
 1-32 license, temporary 24-hour permit, or permit license;
 1-33 (3) a trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or mobile
 1-34 home having an actual gross weight or registered gross weight of
 1-35 7,500 [~~4,500~~] pounds or less;
 1-36 (4) farm machinery, road-building equipment, a farm
 1-37 trailer, or a vehicle required to display a slow-moving-vehicle
 1-38 emblem under Section 547.703;
 1-39 (5) a former military vehicle, as defined by Section
 1-40 504.502;
 1-41 (6) a vehicle qualified for a tax exemption under
 1-42 Section 152.092, Tax Code; or
 1-43 (7) a vehicle for which a certificate of title has been
 1-44 issued but that is not required to be registered.
 1-45 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
