## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to notification by an insurer of certain disciplinary actions imposed on the insurer for a violation of the insurance laws 1-19 1-20 1-21 of another state.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 81.003(b), Insurance Code, is amended to 1-24 read as follows:

(b) An insurer shall notify the commissioner and shall deliver a copy of any applicable order or judgment to the commissioner not later than the 30th day after the date of the: 1-25 1-26 1-27 1-28

(1) suspension or revocation of the insurer's right to transact business in another state; or 1-29 1-30

(2) receipt of an order to show cause why the insurer's 1-31 license in another state should not be suspended or revoked[; or 1-32
