1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the inspection of certain commercial motor vehicles
 1-22 that are not domiciled in this state.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 548.052, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-25 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 548.052. VEHICLES NOT SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. This
 1-27 chapter does not apply to:

1-28 (1) a trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or mobile
 1-29 home moving under or bearing a current factory-delivery license
 1-30 plate or current in-transit license plate;

1-31 (2) a vehicle moving under or bearing a paper dealer
 1-32 in-transit tag, machinery license, disaster license, parade
 1-33 license, prorated tab, one-trip permit, vehicle temporary transit
 1-34 permit, antique license, custom vehicle license, street rod
 1-35 license, temporary 24-hour permit, or permit license;

1-36 (3) a trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or mobile
 1-37 home having an actual gross weight or registered gross weight of
 1-38 4,500 pounds or less;

1-39 (4) farm machinery, road-building equipment, a farm
 1-40 trailer, or a vehicle required to display a slow-moving-vehicle
 1-41 emblem under Section 547.703;

1-42 (5) a former military vehicle, as defined by Section
 1-43 504.502;

1-44 (6) a vehicle qualified for a tax exemption under
 1-45 Section 152.092, Tax Code; ~~or~~

1-46 (7) a vehicle for which a certificate of title has been
 1-47 issued but that is not required to be registered; or

1-48 (8) a vehicle that:

1-49 (A) is not domiciled in this state;

1-50 (B) is registered:

1-51 (i) under the International Registration
 1-52 Plan as authorized by Section 502.091; or

1-53 (ii) as a token trailer under Section
 1-54 502.255, including for an extended period under Section 502.0023;
 1-55 and

1-56 (C) has been issued a certificate of inspection
 1-57 in compliance with federal motor carrier safety regulations.

1-58 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-59 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-60 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

2-1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-2 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
