1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to weight limitations for natural gas motor vehicles.
 1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 621.101, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-24 by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
 1-25 (b-1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,
 1-26 a vehicle or combination of vehicles that is powered by an engine
 1-27 fueled primarily by natural gas may exceed any weight limitation
 1-28 under this section by an amount that is equal to the difference
 1-29 between the weight of the vehicle attributable to the natural gas
 1-30 tank and fueling system carried by that vehicle and the weight of a
 1-31 comparable diesel tank and fueling system, provided that the
 1-32 maximum gross weight of the vehicle or combination of vehicles may
 1-33 not exceed 82,000 pounds.
 1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
