## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to a prohibition on converting high occupancy vehicle 1-20 highway lanes to tolled lanes. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 228.201, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 LIMITATION ON TOLL FACILITY DESIGNATION. Sec. 228.201. 1-25 [<del>(a)</del>] The department may not operate a nontolled state highway or a segment of a nontolled state highway as a toll project, and may 1-26 1-27 not transfer a highway or segment to another entity for operation as 1-28 a toll project, unless:

1-29 (1)the commission by order designated the highway or 1-30 segment as a toll project before the contract to construct the 1-31 highway or segment was awarded;

(2) the project was designated as a toll project in a plan or program of a metropolitan planning organization on or 1-32 1-33 before September 1, 2005; 1-34

1-35 (3) the highway or segment is reconstructed so that 1-36 the number of nontolled lanes on the highway or segment is greater 1-37 than or equal to the number in existence before the reconstruction; 1-38 or

a facility is constructed adjacent to the highway 1-39 (4)or segment so that the number of nontolled lanes on the converted 1-40 1-41 highway or segment and the adjacent facility together is greater 1-42 than or equal to the number in existence on the converted highway or 1-43 segment before the conversion[; or

1 - 44[(5) subject to Subsection (b), the highway or segment to traffic as a high-occupancy vehicle lane on May 1, 1-45 was open 2005]. 1-46

[(b) The department may operate or transfer a high-occupancy vehicle lane under Subsection (a)(5) as a tolled 1-47 1-48 lane only if the department or other entity operating the lane 1-49 allows vehicles occupied by a specified number of passengers to use 1-50 the lane without paying a toll. 1-51

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-52 1-53 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-54 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-55 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-56 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
