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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-15 1-16 AN ACT

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relating to the regulation of seed by a political subdivision. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 61, Agriculture Code, is amended by adding Section 61.019 to read as follows:

<u>O</u>F Sec. 61.019. LOCAL REGULATION SEED PROHIBITED. (a) Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by Subsection (c), a political subdivision may not adopt an order, ordinance, or other measure that regulates agricultural seed, vegetable seed, weed seed, or any other seed in any manner, including planting seed or cultivating plants grown from seed.

(b) An order, ordinance, or other measure adopted political subdivision that violates Subsection (a) is void.

A political subdivision may take any action otherwise (c) prohibited by this section to:

(1) comply with any federal or state requirements;
(2) avoid a federal or state penalty or fine; or

(3) attain or maintain compliance with federal state environmental standards, including state water quality standards.

SECTION 2. Section 61.019(b), Agriculture Code, as added by this Act, applies to an order, ordinance, or other measure adopted before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
