 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to access to criminal history record information.
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 411.0845(e), Government Code, is amended
 1-22 to read as follows:
 1-23 (e) A person entitled to receive criminal history record
 1-24 information under this section must provide the department with the
 1-25 following information regarding the person who is the subject of
 1-26 the criminal history record information requested:
 1-27 (1) the person's full name, date of birth, and sex,
 1-28 ~~[and social security number,~~ and the number assigned to any form of
 1-29 unexpired identification card issued by this state or another
 1-30 state, the District of Columbia, or a territory of the United States
 1-31 that includes the person's photograph;
 1-32 (2) a recent electronic digital image photograph of
 1-33 the person and a complete set of the person's fingerprints as
 1-34 required by the department; and
 1-35 (3) any other information required by the department.
 1-36 SECTION 2. Section 411.086(b), Government Code, is amended
 1-37 to read as follows:
 1-38 (b) Rules adopted by the department:
 1-39 (1) shall provide for a uniform method of requesting
 1-40 criminal history record information from the department;
 1-41 (2) may require a person requesting criminal history
 1-42 record information about an individual to submit to the department
 1-43 one or more of the following:
 1-44 (A) the complete name, race, and sex of the
 1-45 individual;
 1-46 (B) any known alias name of the individual;
 1-47 (C) a complete set of the individual's
 1-48 fingerprints;
 1-49 (D) a recent photograph of the individual;
 1-50 (E) any known identifying number of the
 1-51 individual other than a social security number, including ~~[social~~
 1-52 ~~security number,~~ FBI number, driver's license number, or state
 1-53 identification number;
 1-54 (F) the individual's date of birth;
 1-55 (G) any known alias dates of birth of the
 1-56 individual; or
 1-57 (H) any other information the department
 1-58 determines is necessary to identify the individual or the record;
 1-59 (3) shall provide for the methods and formats for
 1-60 dissemination of criminal history record information; and
 1-61 (4) shall provide security measures and policies that

2-1 are designed to guard against unauthorized release or dissemination
2-2 of criminal history record information that is maintained or
2-3 disseminated by the department.

2-4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
