A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to a reduction in required days of service for educators in 1-21 1-22 1-23 public schools under certain circumstances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 21.401, Education Code, is amended by 1-24 1-25 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as 1-26 follows:

1-27 1-28 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), an [An] educator employed under a 10-month contract must provide a minimum of 187 1-29 days of service.

(c-1) If a school district anticipates providing less than 180 days of instruction for students during a school year, as indicated by the district's academic calendar, the district may reduce the number of days of service required by this section 1-30 1-31 1-32 1-33 A reduction by the district does not reduce an 1-34 proportionately. 1-35

educator's salary. SECTION 2. Section 21.401, Education Code, as amended by 1-36 this Act, applies only to a contract executed on or after the effective date of this Act. A contract executed before the 1-37 1-38 1-39 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the contract was executed, and the former law is continued in 1-40 1-41 effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-42 1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1 - 441-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
