1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to allowing the holder of a brewpub license to sell beer,  
1-22 ale, and malt liquor to certain qualified persons outside the  
1-23 state.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 74.09(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is  
1-26 amended to read as follows:

1-27 (a) In addition to the activities authorized by Section  
1-28 74.01, the holder of a brewpub license may sell beer produced under  
1-29 the license to the holder of a general, local, or branch  
1-30 distributor's license or to qualified distributors or other  
1-31 similarly situated entities outside the state.

1-32 SECTION 2. Section 74.10(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is  
1-33 amended to read as follows:

1-34 (a) In addition to the activities authorized by Section  
1-35 74.01, the holder of a brewpub license may sell ale and malt liquor  
1-36 to the holder of a wholesaler's permit, a general class B  
1-37 wholesaler's permit, or a local class B wholesaler's permit or to  
1-38 qualified wholesalers or other similarly situated entities outside  
1-39 the state.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-41 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-42 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-43 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
