1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to county approval for the locations at which a junkyard or  
 1-18 automotive wrecking and salvage yard may be operated.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 396.041(c), Transportation Code, is  
 1-21 amended to read as follows:

1-22 (c) An ordinance may:

1-23 (1) impose a fee of \$25 for the issuance or renewal of  
 1-24 a license;

1-25 (2) impose a fee of not more than:

1-26 (A) \$150 for the issuance or renewal of a  
 1-27 license, if the ordinance is adopted by the commissioners court of a  
 1-28 county with a population of one million or more that contains two or  
 1-29 more municipalities, each of which has a population of 250,000 or  
 1-30 more; or

1-31 (B) \$500 for the issuance or renewal of a  
 1-32 license, if the ordinance is adopted by the commissioners court of a  
 1-33 county with a population of 3.3 million or more;

1-34 (3) condition the license on the operation of the  
 1-35 junkyard or automotive wrecking and salvage yard only at a location  
 1-36 approved by the commissioners court or a county employee designated  
 1-37 by the commissioners court; or

1-38 (4) establish grounds for suspending or revoking a  
 1-39 license if the junkyard or automotive wrecking and salvage yard is  
 1-40 not screened.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
