 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to use of tax revenue by certain development corporations
 1-22 for job-related skills training.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 501.163(a), Local Government Code, is
 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (a) This section applies only to a corporation the creation
 1-27 of which was authorized by a municipality that:

1-28 (1) has a population of 10,000 or more;

1-29 (2) is located in a county that borders:

1-30 (A) ~~bordering~~ the Gulf of Mexico or the Gulf
 1-31 Intracoastal Waterway; or

1-32 (B) the United Mexican States and in which four
 1-33 municipalities with a population of 70,000 or more are located; and

1-34 (3) has, or is included in a metropolitan statistical
 1-35 area of this state that has, an unemployment rate that averaged at
 1-36 least two percent above the state average for the most recent two
 1-37 consecutive years for which statistics are available.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
