 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to appraisal of public school teachers.
 1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 21.351, Education Code, is amended by
 1-24 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
 1-25 (e) Under the recommended appraisal process, a student
 1-26 evaluation may not be used as a criterion on which to appraise the
 1-27 performance of a teacher.
 1-28 SECTION 2. Section 21.352, Education Code, is amended by
 1-29 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
 1-30 (g) Under the appraisal process developed under this
 1-31 section, a student evaluation may not be used as a criterion on
 1-32 which to appraise the performance of a teacher.
 1-33 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
 1-34 school year.
 1-35 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
