5	SECTION 1. Sections 61.0763(a), (b), (c), and (d),
6	Education Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(a) [In this section, "career school or college" has the
8	meaning assigned by Section 132.001.
9	[(b)] Not later than January 1, 2014, [the board shall
10	establish and administer] a pilot program shall be established at
11	selected postsecondary educational institutions to ensure that
12	students of those institutions are informed consumers with regard
13	to all aspects of student financial aid, including:
14	(1) the consequences of borrowing to finance a
15	student's postsecondary education;
16	(2) the financial consequences of a student's academic
17	and career choices; and
18	(3) strategies for avoiding student loan delinquency
19	and default.
20	(b) At [(c) The board shall select at] least one
21	institution from each of the following categories of postsecondary
22	educational institutions <u>must be selected</u> to participate in the
23	program:
24	(1) general academic teaching institutions;

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(2) public junior colleges; and 1 2 (3) private or independent institutions of higher education[; and 3 4 [(4)]career schools or colleges]. postsecondary 5 (c) [(d)] In selecting educational institutions to participate in the pilot program, [the board shall 6 7 give] priority shall be given to institutions that are recognized by the United States Department of Education as minority-serving 8 9 institutions, including minority institutions under Section 1067k of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. Section 1001 et seq.) 10 11 [have a three-year cohort student loan default rate, as reported by the United States Department of Education: 12 13 [(1) of more than 20 percent; or 14 [(2) that has above average growth as compared to the rates of other postsecondary educational institutions in this 15 16 state]. SECTION 2. Section 57.011, Education Code, is amended by 17 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows: 18 (f) In accordance with an agreement with the Texas Higher 19 Education Coordinating Board, the Texas Guaranteed Student Loan 20 Corporation shall administer the pilot program established under 21 Section 61.0763. The corporation shall submit to the governor, the 22 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 23 representatives any annual report or end of program report the 24 corporation submits to the United States Department of Education in 25 administering the pilot program. This subsection expires December 26 27 31, 2019.

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1 SECTION 3. Sections 61.0763(e), (f), and (g), Education 2 Code, are repealed.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
