1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the multiuse training and operations center facility.  
1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-19 SECTION 1. Section 411.0141, Government Code, is amended to  
1-20 read as follows:  
1-21 Sec. 411.0141. MULTIUSE TRAINING AND OPERATIONS CENTER  
1-22 FACILITY. (a) The Texas Facilities Commission shall construct a  
1-23 multiuse training and operations center facility to be used by the  
1-24 department, the Texas military forces, county and municipal law  
1-25 enforcement agencies, and any other military or law enforcement  
1-26 agency, including agencies of the federal government:  
1-27 (1) [✓] for training purposes;  
1-28 (2) to house law enforcement assets and equipment; and  
1-29 (3) to support and initiate tactical operations and  
1-30 law enforcement missions.  
1-31 (b) The Texas Facilities Commission, with the assistance of  
1-32 the department, shall locate and acquire real property for the  
1-33 purpose of constructing the training and operations center  
1-34 facility. The governing body of a county, ~~[or]~~ municipality, or  
1-35 navigation district, on behalf of the county, ~~[or]~~ municipality, or  
1-36 navigation district, may donate real property to the department for  
1-37 the ~~[training]~~ facility. The donation may be in fee simple or  
1-38 otherwise.  
1-39 (c) The department shall, with the assistance of the Texas  
1-40 Facilities Commission, design the training and operations center  
1-41 facility.  
1-42 (d) On completion of the construction of the training and  
1-43 operations center facility, the Texas Facilities Commission shall  
1-44 transfer ownership of the ~~[training]~~ facility, including the real  
1-45 property and buildings, to the department.  
1-46 (e) The department shall manage the training and operations  
1-47 center facility and may adopt rules necessary to implement this  
1-48 section. The department shall make the ~~[training]~~ facility  
1-49 available for use by the department, the Texas military forces,  
1-50 county and municipal law enforcement agencies, and any other  
1-51 military or law enforcement agency, including agencies of the  
1-52 federal government. The department may set and collect fees for the  
1-53 use of the ~~[training]~~ facility.  
1-54 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
