## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-17 relating to the multiuse training and operations center facility. 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 411.0141, Government Code, is amended to 1-20 read as follows:

MULTIUSE TRAINING AND OPERATIONS 1-21 Sec. 411.0141. CENTER 1-22 1-23 FACILITY. (a) The Texas Facilities Commission shall construct a multiuse training and operations center facility to be used by the department, the Texas military forces, county and municipal law 1-24 enforcement agencies, and any other military or law enforcement 1-25 1-26 agency, including agencies of the federal government:

 $[\tau]$  for training purposes;

1-27 1-28  $\frac{(1)}{(2)}$ to house law enforcement assets and equipment; and (3) to support and initiate tactical operations and 1-29 1-30 law enforcement missions.

(b) The Texas Facilities Commission, with the assistance of the department, shall locate and acquire real property for the 1-31 1-32 the department, shall locate and acquire real property for the purpose of constructing the training <u>and operations center</u> facility. The governing body of a county, [<del>or</del>] municipality, <u>or</u> <u>navigation district</u>, on behalf of the county, [<del>or</del>] municipality, <u>or</u> <u>navigation district</u>, may donate real property to the department for the [training] facility. The donation may be in fee simple or 1-33 1-34 1-35 1-36 1-37 1-38 otherwise.

1-39 (c) The department shall, with the assistance of the Texas 1-40 Facilities Commission, design the training and operations center facility. 1-41

(d) On completion of the construction of the training and operations center facility, the Texas Facilities Commission shall 1-42 1-43 transfer ownership of the [training] facility, including the real 1-44 1-45 property and buildings, to the department.

(e) The department shall manage the training <u>and operations</u> <u>center</u> facility and may adopt rules necessary to implement this section. The department shall make the [training] facility 1-46 1-47 1-48 available for use by the department, the Texas military forces, county and municipal law enforcement agencies, and any other 1-49 1-50 military or law enforcement agency, including agencies of the federal government.
