1-24 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-25 AN ACT

1-26 relating to the eligibility of public institutions of higher  
 1-27 education for formula funding for health-related institutions.

1-28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-29 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is  
 1-30 amended by adding Section 61.0591 to read as follows:

1-31 Sec. 61.0591. ELIGIBILITY FOR CERTAIN FORMULA FUNDING. An  
 1-32 institution of higher education created on or after January 1,  
 1-33 2017, is eligible for formula funding under formulas established  
 1-34 for health-related institutions under Section 61.059 only if a  
 1-35 statute:

1-36 (1) created or authorized creation of the particular  
 1-37 institution; or

1-38 (2) expressly provides that the particular  
 1-39 institution is eligible for that formula funding.

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-41 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-42 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-43 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
