1-24 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-25 AN ACT

1-26 relating to an annual report on state programs not funded by
 1-27 appropriations.

1-28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-29 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
 1-30 amended by adding Section 403.0147 to read as follows:

1-31 Sec. 403.0147. REPORT ON STATE PROGRAMS NOT FUNDED BY
 1-32 APPROPRIATIONS. (a) In this section, "state agency" means an
 1-33 agency, department, board, commission, or other entity in the
 1-34 executive, legislative, or judicial branch of state government.

1-35 (b) Not later than December 31 of each year, the comptroller
 1-36 shall submit a report to the legislature that identifies for each
 1-37 state agency:

1-38 (1) each program the state agency is statutorily
 1-39 required to implement for which no appropriation was made for the
 1-40 preceding state fiscal year, along with a citation to the law
 1-41 imposing the requirement; and

1-42 (2) the amount and source of money the state agency
 1-43 spent, if any, to implement any portion of the program described by
 1-44 Subdivision (1) during the preceding state fiscal year.

1-45 (c) A state agency shall provide to the comptroller not
 1-46 later than September 30 of each year information necessary for the
 1-47 comptroller to prepare the report required by this section. The
 1-48 comptroller may prescribe the form and content of the information a
 1-49 state agency must provide.

1-50 SECTION 2. The comptroller of public accounts shall submit
 1-51 the initial report required by Section 403.0147, Government Code,
 1-52 as added by this Act, not later than December 31, 2017.

1-53 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-54 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-55 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-56 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-57 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
