- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.043, Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 21.043. ACCESS TO PEIMS DATA. (a) The agency shall
- 8 provide the board with access to data obtained under the Public
- 9 Education Information Management System (PEIMS).
- 10 (b) The agency shall provide educator preparation programs
- 11 with data based on information reported through the Public
- 12 Education Information Management System (PEIMS) that enables an
- 13 educator preparation program to:

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- 14 (1) assess the impact of the program; and
- 15 (2) revise the program as needed to improve the design
- 16 and effectiveness of the program.
- 17 (c) The agency in coordination with the board shall solicit
- 18 input from educator preparation programs to determine the data to
- 19 be provided to educator preparation programs.
- SECTION 2. Section 21.045, Education Code, is amended by
- 21 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 22 (d) To assist an educator preparation program in improving
- 23 the design and effectiveness of the program in preparing educators
- 24 for the classroom, the agency shall provide to each program data

- 1 that is compiled and analyzed by the agency based on information
- 2 reported through the Public Education Information Management
- 3 System (PEIMS) relating to the program.
- 4 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 21.0489 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 21.0489. EARLY CHILDHOOD CERTIFICATION. (a) To
- 7 ensure that there are teachers with special training in early
- 8 childhood education focusing on prekindergarten through grade
- 9 three, the board shall establish an early childhood certificate.
- 10 (b) A person is not required to hold a certificate
- 11 established under this section to be employed by a school district
- 12 to provide instruction in prekindergarten through grade three.
- 13 (c) To be eligible for a certificate established under this
- 14 section, a person must:
- 15 (1) either:
- 16 (A) satisfactorily complete the course work for
- 17 that certificate in an educator preparation program, including a
- 18 knowledge-based and skills-based course of instruction on early
- 19 childhood education that includes:
- 20 (i) teaching methods for:
- 21 (a) using small group instructional
- 22 formats that focus on building social, emotional, and academic
- 23 <u>skills;</u>
- (b) navigating multiple content
- 25 <u>areas; and</u>
- 26 (c) managing a classroom environment
- 27 in which small groups of students are working on different tasks;

- 1 and
- 2 <u>(ii)</u> strategies for teaching fundamental
- 3 academic skills, including reading, writing, and numeracy; or
- 4 (B) hold an early childhood through grade six
- 5 certificate issued under this subchapter and satisfactorily
- 6 complete a course of instruction described by Paragraph (A);
- 7 (2) perform satisfactorily on an early childhood
- 8 <u>certificate examination prescribed by the board; and</u>
- 9 (3) satisfy any other requirements prescribed by the
- 10 board.
- 11 (d) The criteria for the course of instruction described by
- 12 Subsection (c)(1)(A) shall be developed by the board in
- 13 consultation with faculty members who provide instruction at
- 14 institutions of higher education in educator preparation programs
- 15 for an early childhood through grade six certificate.
- SECTION 4. Section 21.052, Education Code, is amended by
- 17 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 18 (a-1) The commissioner may adopt rules establishing
- 19 exceptions to the examination requirements prescribed by
- 20 Subsection (a)(3) for an educator from outside the state to obtain a
- 21 certificate in this state.
- SECTION 5. Section 30A.112(b), Education Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 (b) The state virtual school network may provide or
- 25 authorize providers of electronic professional development courses
- 26 to provide professional development for:
- 27 (1) teachers who are teaching subjects or grade levels

- 1 for which the teachers are not certified; or
- 2 (2) [teachers who must become highly qualified under
- 3 Section 1119, No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (20 U.S.C. Section
- 4 6319); or
- 5 $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ teachers who must become qualified under the
- 6 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (20 U.S.C. Section 1400
- 7 et seq.).
- 8 SECTION 6. The following provisions of the Education Code
- 9 are repealed:
- 10 (1) Section 21.005;
- 11 (2) Section 21.052(g); and
- 12 (3) Section 21.057(e).
- 13 SECTION 7. The State Board for Educator Certification shall
- 14 propose rules:
- 15 (1) establishing requirements and prescribing an
- 16 examination for an early childhood certificate examination as
- 17 required by Section 21.0489, Education Code, as added by this Act;
- 18 and
- 19 (2) establishing standards to govern the approval and
- 20 renewal of approval of educator preparation programs for early
- 21 childhood certification.
- 22 SECTION 8. The commissioner of education is required to
- 23 implement Sections 1 and 2 of this Act only if the legislature
- 24 appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If the
- 25 legislature does not appropriate money specifically for the purpose
- 26 of implementing Sections 1 and 2 of this Act, the commissioner of
- 27 education may, but is not required to, implement those sections
