1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to requiring the review of public school district
 1-24 paperwork to limit paperwork requirements.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 11.164, Education Code, is amended by
 1-27 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

1-28 (b-1) Not less than once every six months, each
 1-29 district-level committee established under Section 11.251 shall
 1-30 review paperwork requirements imposed on classroom teachers and
 1-31 shall make recommendations to the board of trustees of the school
 1-32 district regarding the transfer to existing noninstructional staff
 1-33 of a reporting task that can reasonably be accomplished by that
 1-34 staff as authorized by Subsection (b).

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
