S.B. No. 1929

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to maternal mortality and morbidity and pregnancy-related
- 3 deaths, including postpartum depression.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 34.005, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 34.005. DUTIES OF TASK FORCE. The task force shall:
- 8 (1) study and review:
- 9 (A) cases of pregnancy-related deaths; and
- 10 (B) trends, rates, or disparities in
- 11 pregnancy-related deaths and [in] severe maternal morbidity;
- 12 (2) determine the feasibility of the task force
- 13 studying cases of severe maternal morbidity; and
- 14 (3) make recommendations to help reduce the incidence
- 15 of pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity in this
- 16 state.
- SECTION 2. Sections 34.007(a) and (b), Health and Safety
- 18 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) The department shall determine a statistically
- 20 significant number of cases of pregnancy-related deaths for review.
- 21 The department shall either randomly select cases or select all
- 22 cases for the task force to review under this subsection to reflect
- 23 a cross-section of pregnancy-related deaths in this state.
- 24 (b) The department shall statistically analyze aggregate

- 1 data of pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity in
- 2 this state to identify any trends, rates, or disparities.
- 3 SECTION 3. Chapter 34, Health and Safety Code, is amended by
- 4 adding Section 34.0155 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 34.0155. REPORT ON MATERNAL MORTALITY AND
- 6 PREGNANCY-RELATED DEATHS. The commission shall:
- 7 (1) evaluate options for reducing maternal mortality,
- 8 focusing on the most prevalent causes of maternal mortality as
- 9 <u>identified in the task force's biennial report required under</u>
- 10 Section 34.015, and for treating postpartum depression in
- 11 <u>economically disadvantaged women;</u>
- 12 (2) submit a written report that summarizes the
- 13 commission's <u>efforts to accomplish the tasks described by</u>
- 14 Subdivision (1) to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the
- 15 speaker of the house of representatives, the Legislative Budget
- 16 Board, and the appropriate standing committees of the legislature
- 17 not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year; and
- 18 (3) to the extent authorized by state and federal law,
- 19 apply for federal money to fund the screening and treatment of
- 20 postpartum depression under Section 10005 of the 21st Century Cures
- 21 Act (42 U.S.C. Section 201 et seq.) and consider the
- 22 recommendations contained in the task force's biennial report in
- 23 using any federal grant money received.
- SECTION 4. Section 34.018, Health and Safety Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 34.018. SUNSET PROVISION. The task force is subject to
- 27 Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued

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- 1 in existence as provided by that chapter, the task force is
- 2 abolished and this chapter expires December 31, 2023 [September 1,
- 3 2019].
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
