1-19 relating to the transportation or storage of a handgun or other
 1-20 firearm or ammunition by a license holder in a motor vehicle in a
 1-21 parking area of a primary or secondary school.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
 1-24 amended by adding Section 411.2033 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 411.2033. TRANSPORTATION OR STORAGE OF FIREARM AND
 1-26 AMMUNITION BY LICENSE HOLDER IN SCHOOL PARKING AREA. (a) In this
 1-27 section:

1-28 (1) "Open-enrollment charter school" has the meaning
 1-29 assigned by Section 5.001, Education Code.

1-30 (2) "Private school" has the meaning assigned by
 1-31 Section 22.081, Education Code.

1-32 (b) A school district, open-enrollment charter school, or
 1-33 private school may not prohibit a person, including a school
 1-34 employee, who holds a license to carry a handgun under this
 1-35 subchapter from transporting or storing a handgun or other firearm
 1-36 or ammunition in a locked, privately owned or leased motor vehicle
 1-37 in a parking lot, parking garage, or other parking area provided by
 1-38 the district or charter or private school, provided that the
 1-39 handgun, firearm, or ammunition is not in plain view.

1-40 (c) This section does not authorize a person to possess,
 1-41 store, or transport a handgun, firearm, or ammunition in violation
 1-42 of Section 37.125, Education Code, Section 46.03 or 46.035, Penal
 1-43 Code, or other law.

1-44 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
