The Daughters of the Republic of Texas shall be allowed a reasonable time after completion of the 2-43 2-44 inventory to remove any personal property and fixtures owned by the 2-45 2-46 organization.

(b) Any dispute regarding the ownership of personal property and fixtures located at the French Legation shall be resolved through alternative dispute resolution as provided by 2-47 2-48 2-49 2-50 Chapter 2009, Government Code.

2-51 (c) The Daughters of the Republic of Texas may transfer any 2-52 property of the organization described by this section to the Texas 2-53 Historical Commission.

2-54 SECTION 7. On September 1, 2017, the following are 2-55 transferred to the Texas Historical Commission:

2-56 (1) all powers and duties of the Daughters of the 2-57 Republic of Texas relating to the property known as the French 2-58 Legation;

(2) all state-owned assets in the possession of the 2-59 Daughters of the Republic of Texas relating to the French Legation; 2-60 2-61 and

2-62 (3) all files and other records of the Daughters of the 2-63 Republic of Texas kept by the organization regarding the French Legation. 2-64

SECTION 8. On September 1, 2-65 2017, the following are 2-66 transferred to the Texas Historical Commission:

3-14 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
