18	shall develop and maintain a grant program that awards grants for
19	the expenses incurred by a local law enforcement agency related to
20	the attendance of a law enforcement officer of the agency in a
21	training program.
22	(b) A local law enforcement agency may apply to the office
23	of the governor in the form and manner required by the office of the
24	governor for a grant under the grant program established by this
