1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the requirement that the Texas Workforce Commission  
1-22 provide certain employment information for secondary school  
1-23 students.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 302.014(a), Labor Code, is amended to  
1-26 read as follows:

1-27 (a) The commission shall provide the Texas Education Agency  
1-28 with information at least each quarter, disaggregated by county or  
1-29 other appropriate region, regarding:

1-30 (1) current and projected employment opportunities in  
1-31 this state;

1-32 (2) career and technical education partnership  
1-33 opportunities with business and industry; and

1-34 (3) professional development opportunities for  
1-35 teachers and learning opportunities for students through industry  
1-36 mentorships, internships, summer programs, after-school programs,  
1-37 and career-based student leadership opportunities ~~[, disaggregated~~  
1-38 ~~by county or other appropriate region].~~

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
