1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the average daily attendance calculation for students
1-23 over 18 years of age who are in an off home campus instructional
1-24 arrangement.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section [42.151](#), Education Code, is amended by
1-27 adding Subsection (f-1) to read as follows:

1-28 (f-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (f), a student who is 18
1-29 years of age or older who has met graduation credit requirements and
1-30 is in an off home campus instructional arrangement is a full-time
1-31 equivalent student if the student receives 20 hours of contact a
1-32 week. A student described by this subsection is a part-time
1-33 equivalent student if the student receives 10 hours or more but less
1-34 than 20 hours of contact a week. The commissioner may adopt rules
1-35 necessary to administer this section.

1-36 SECTION 2. The commissioner of education may adopt rules to
1-37 administer this Act.

1-38 SECTION 3. The commissioner of education is required to
1-39 implement this Act only if the legislature appropriates money
1-40 specifically for that purpose. If the legislature does not
1-41 appropriate money specifically for that purpose, the commissioner
1-42 of education may, but is not required to, implement this Act using
1-43 other appropriations available for the purpose.

1-44 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
1-45 school year.
