In the event of an accident involving an automated motor vehicle, the automated motor vehicle or any human operator of the automated motor vehicle shall, regardless of whether the operator is required to do so under Chapter 550:

(1) stop the vehicle at or return the vehicle to the scene of the accident; and

immediately by the quickest means of communication (2) give notice of the accident to the:

(A) local police department if the accident

occurred in a municipality;
(B) local police department or the sheriff's office if the accident occurred not more than 100 feet outside the

limits of a municipality; or

(2) an automated driving system installed on the automated motor vehicle.
