Relating to conditions of community supervision for defendants convicted of certain criminal offenses involving animals.

HB 524 Villalba | et al.  
Relating to the punishment for certain offenses involving family violence; changing the eligibility for parole and mandatory supervision for those offenses.

Relating to the procedure for expunction of arrest records and files for certain persons who are tried for an offense and subsequently acquitted.

Relating to the admissibility of certain recorded statements made by child abuse victims.

Relating to prohibiting the reckless discharge of a firearm; creating an offense.

Relating to the eligibility of a criminal defendant for an order of nondisclosure of criminal history record information.
