1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the operation of open-enrollment charter schools on
 1-22 Memorial Day.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 25.081(f), Education Code, as added by
 1-25 Chapter 1144 (H.B. 441), Acts of the 85th Legislature, Regular
 1-26 Session, 2017, is amended to read as follows:

1-27 (f) A school district or open-enrollment charter school may
 1-28 not provide student instruction on Memorial Day. If a school
 1-29 district or open-enrollment charter school would be required to
 1-30 provide student instruction on Memorial Day to compensate for
 1-31 minutes of instruction lost because of school closures caused by
 1-32 disaster, flood, extreme weather conditions, fuel curtailment, or
 1-33 another calamity, the commissioner shall approve the instruction of
 1-34 students for fewer than the number of minutes required under
 1-35 Subsection (a).

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
 1-37 school year.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
