- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person is eligible to have the person's name on the
- 8 monument if the person was killed in the line of duty and was:
- 9 (1) a law enforcement officer or peace officer for
- 10 this state or a political subdivision of this state under Article
- 11 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, or other law;
- 12 (2) a federal law enforcement officer or special agent
- 13 performing duties in this state, including those officers under
- 14 Article 2.122, Code of Criminal Procedure; [or]
- 15 (3) a corrections or detention officer or county or
- 16 municipal jailer employed or appointed by a municipal, county, or
- 17 state penal institution in this state; or
- 18 (4) employed by this state or a political subdivision
- 19 of this state and considered by the person's employer to be a
- 20 trainee for a position described by Subdivision (1), (2), or (3).
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
