1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to proclamations for the production of instructional  
 1-24 materials and selection of instructional materials by public  
 1-25 schools.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Section 31.002, Education Code, is amended by  
 1-28 adding Subdivision (1-b) to read as follows:

1-29 (1-b) "Proclamation" means a request for production of  
 1-30 instructional materials issued by the State Board of Education.

1-31 SECTION 2. Section 31.022, Education Code, is amended by  
 1-32 adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) and amending Subsection (f) to  
 1-33 read as follows:

1-34 (b-1) For any state fiscal biennium, the board may only  
 1-35 issue proclamations for instructional materials in which the total  
 1-36 projected cost of instructional materials under the proclamations  
 1-37 does not exceed 75 percent of the total amount used to fund the  
 1-38 instructional materials and technology allotment under Section  
 1-39 31.0211 for that biennium.

1-40 (b-2) In determining the disbursement of money to the  
 1-41 available school fund and the amount of that disbursement that will  
 1-42 be used, in accordance with Section 43.001(d), to fund the  
 1-43 instructional materials and technology allotment under Section  
 1-44 31.0211, the board must consider the cost of all instructional  
 1-45 materials and technology requirements for that state fiscal  
 1-46 biennium.

1-47 (f) The board shall amend any proclamation [~~request for~~  
 1-48 ~~production~~] issued for the purchase of instructional materials to  
 1-49 conform to the instructional materials funding levels provided by  
 1-50 the General Appropriations Act for the year of implementation and  
 1-51 to comply with Subsection (b-1).

1-52 SECTION 3. Sections 31.101(d) and (e), Education Code, are  
 1-53 repealed.

1-54 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
