BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 16.012, Water Code, is amended by adding Subsection (h-1) to read as follows: 1-24

(h-1) Not later than December 1, 2022, the commission shall obtain or develop updated water availability models for the Brazos River, Neches River, Red River, and Rio Grande river basins. The 1-25 1-26 1-27 commission may collect data from all jurisdictions that allocate 1-28 the waters of the rivers, including jurisdictions outside this state. This subsection expires September 1, 2023. 1-29 state. This sur SECTION 2. 1-30

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality is 1-31 1-32 required to implement a provision of this Act only if the legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If 1-33 1-34 the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that 1-35 purpose, the commission may, but is not required to, implement a 1-36 provision of this Act using other appropriations available for that 1-37 purpose. 1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
