1-20 relating to an expedited on-site health inspection process for  
 1-21 assisted living facility license applicants.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 247.0211, Health and  
 1-24 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 247.0211. EXPEDITED [~~LIFE SAFETY CODE~~] INSPECTION.

1-26 SECTION 2. Section 247.0211(a), Health and Safety Code, is  
 1-27 amended to read as follows:

1-28 (a) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules to  
 1-29 implement an expedited inspection process that allows an applicant  
 1-30 for an assisted living facility license or for a renewal of a  
 1-31 license to obtain:

1-32 (1) a life safety code and physical plant inspection  
 1-33 not later than the 15th day after the date the request is made; or

1-34 (2) an on-site health inspection not later than the  
 1-35 21st day after the date the request is made.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
