1-20 relating to the duration of a bingo occasion.
 1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-22 SECTION 1. Section 2001.103(b), Occupations Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:
 1-24 (b) A temporary license is valid for six [~~four~~] hours during
 1-25 any one day.
 1-26 SECTION 2. Section 2001.419(b), Occupations Code, is
 1-27 amended to read as follows:
 1-28 (b) A bingo occasion may not exceed six [~~four~~] hours.
 1-29 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
 1-30 bingo occasion conducted under a license issued under Chapter 2001,
 1-31 Occupations Code, before, on, or after the effective date of this
 1-32 Act. The holder of an unused temporary license issued before the
 1-33 effective date of this Act may submit to the Texas Lottery
 1-34 Commission, in the manner required by the commission, a license
 1-35 amendment or a notification that provides the specific date and
 1-36 time of the bingo occasion for which the temporary license will be
 1-37 used, and the commission may adopt the rules and procedures
 1-38 necessary to accomplish that purpose.
 1-39 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-40 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-41 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-42 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-43 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
