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- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 104.011(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The statewide health coordinating council is composed
- 8 of 17 members determined as follows:
- 9 (1) the executive commissioner or a representative
- 10 designated by the executive commissioner;
- 11 (2) the chair of the Texas Higher Education
- 12 Coordinating Board or a representative designated by the presiding
- 13 officer;
- 14 (3) the commissioner or a representative designated by
- 15 the commissioner;
- 16 (4) the commissioner of the Texas Education Agency
- 17 [aging and disability services] or a representative designated by
- 18 the commissioner of the Texas Education Agency [aging and
- 19 disability services]; and
- 20 (5) the following members appointed by the governor:
- 21 (A) three health care professionals from the
- 22 allied health, dental, medical, mental health, and pharmacy
- 23 professions, no two of whom may be from the same profession;
- 24 (B) one registered nurse;

- 1 (C) two representatives of a university or
- 2 health-related institution of higher education;
- 3 (D) one representative of a junior or community
- 4 college with a nursing program;
- 5 (E) one hospital administrator;
- 6 (F) one managed care administrator; and
- 7 (G) four public members.
- SECTION 2. On the effective date of this 8 Act, commissioner of the Texas Education Agency or a representative designated by the commissioner of the Texas Education Agency 10 replaces the member appointed to the position held by the former 11 commissioner of aging and disability services or designee as a 12 member of the statewide health coordinating council, in accordance 13 with Section 104.011, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this 14 15 Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
