1-16 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to an annual report concerning the number of inmates who
 1-19 have been in the conservatorship of a state agency responsible for
 1-20 providing child protective services.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 501.023(b), Government Code, is amended
 1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (b) Not later than December 31 of each year, the department
 1-25 shall submit a report to the governor, the lieutenant governor,
 1-26 ~~[the speaker of the house of representatives,]~~ and each member of
 1-27 the legislature and shall make the report available to the public on
 1-28 the department's Internet website ~~[standing committee having~~
 1-29 ~~primary jurisdiction over the department]~~. The report must
 1-30 summarize statistical information concerning the total number of
 1-31 inmates who have at any time been in the conservatorship of a state
 1-32 agency responsible for providing child protective services,
 1-33 including, disaggregated by age, the number of inmates who have not
 1-34 previously served a term of imprisonment.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
