 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of the portion of U.S. Highway 84 in
 1-20 Limestone County as the Trooper Damon Allen Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.152 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.152. TROOPER DAMON ALLEN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)
 1-25 The portion of U.S. Highway 84 in Limestone County is designated as
 1-26 the Trooper Damon Allen Memorial Highway.

1-27 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-28 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-29 designation as the Trooper Damon Allen Memorial Highway and any
 1-30 other appropriate information; and

1-31 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-32 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
