1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the extended registration of certain vehicles not
 1-23 subject to inspection.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
 1-26 is amended by adding Section 502.0024 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 502.0024. EXTENDED REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN VEHICLES
 1-28 NOT SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. (a) Notwithstanding Section
 1-29 502.044(c), the department shall develop and implement a system of
 1-30 registration to allow an owner of a vehicle described by Section
 1-31 548.052(3) other than a mobile home to register the vehicle for an
 1-32 extended registration period of not more than five years. The owner
 1-33 may select the number of years for registration under this section
 1-34 within that range and register the vehicle for that period. Payment
 1-35 for all applicable fees, including any optional fee imposed under
 1-36 Subchapter H and other registration fees and the fee required by
 1-37 Section 548.510, for the entire registration period selected is due
 1-38 at the time of registration.

1-39 (b) The fee required by Section 548.510 shall be remitted to
 1-40 the comptroller for deposit in the Texas mobility fund, the general
 1-41 revenue fund, and the clean air account in amounts proportionate to
 1-42 the allocation prescribed by Subsection (b) of that section.

1-43 (c) The fees imposed under Subchapter H shall be collected
 1-44 and remitted as prescribed by that subchapter.

1-45 SECTION 2. Not later than February 1, 2020, the Texas
 1-46 Department of Motor Vehicles shall adopt the system required by
 1-47 Section 502.0024, Transportation Code, as added by this Act, and
 1-48 any rules necessary to implement that section.

1-49 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-50 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-51 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-52 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-53 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
