 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the inspection of a municipal solid waste management
 1-24 facility or site by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality
 1-25 before a permit application is issued, amended, extended, or
 1-26 renewed.

1-27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-28 SECTION 1. Section 361.088, Health and Safety Code, is
 1-29 amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:

1-30 (h) Before a permit for a proposed municipal solid waste
 1-31 management facility is issued, amended, extended, or renewed, the
 1-32 commission shall inspect the facility or site used or proposed to be
 1-33 used to store, process, or dispose of municipal solid waste to
 1-34 confirm information included in the permit application. The
 1-35 commission by rule shall prescribe the kinds of information in a
 1-36 permit application that require confirmation under this
 1-37 subsection.

1-38 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
 1-39 an application for a permit, license, registration, or other
 1-40 authorization for a municipal solid waste facility that is filed
 1-41 with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the
 1-42 effective date of this Act. An application for a permit, license,
 1-43 registration, or other authorization for a municipal solid waste
 1-44 facility that is filed before the effective date of this Act is
 1-45 governed by the law in effect on the date of filing, and that law is
 1-46 continued in effect for that purpose.

1-47 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
