1-17 relating to a common characteristic or use project in a public
 1-18 improvement district in certain municipalities.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 372.0035, Local Government Code, is
 1-21 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to
 1-22 read as follows:

1-23 (a) This section applies only to:

1-24 (1) a municipality that:

1-25 (A) has a population of more than 650,000 and
 1-26 less than two million; ~~or~~

1-27 (B) has a population of more than 325,000 and
 1-28 less than 625,000; or

1-29 (C) has a population of more than 105,000 and is
 1-30 wholly located in a county with a population of less than 250,000;
 1-31 and

1-32 (2) a public improvement district established under
 1-33 this subchapter and solely composed of territory in which the only
 1-34 businesses are:

1-35 (A) hotels with 100 or more rooms ordinarily used
 1-36 for sleeping, if the district is established by a municipality
 1-37 described by Subdivision (1)(A); or

1-38 (B) hotels with 75 or more rooms ordinarily used
 1-39 for sleeping, if the district is established by a municipality
 1-40 described by Subdivision (1)(B) or (C).

1-41 (e) A municipality may undertake a project under this
 1-42 section only for a purpose described by Section 372.003(b)(13).

1-43 SECTION 2. The limitation on authority imposed by Section
 1-44 372.0035(e), Local Government Code, as added by this Act, applies
 1-45 only to a common characteristic or use project undertaken by a
 1-46 municipality on or after the effective date of this Act.

1-47 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
