1-26 1-27 Except as provided by Subsection (c), the district clerk (b) shall obtain one or more [a] surety bonds in accordance with this 1-28 section [bond] to cover each [a] deputy clerk or other employee. 1-29 The district clerk shall obtain:

(1) an individual bond for each deputy clerk and other in an amount for each bond that is equal to the district 1-30 1-31 employee clerk's bond; or (2) 1-32

1-33 a schedule surety bond or a blanket surety bond to cover <u>all deputy clerks</u> [more than one deputy] and all <u>other</u> employees <u>in a total amount that is equal to the district clerk's</u> <u>bond</u> [of the office]. 1-34 1-35 1-36

1-37 (b-1) A deputy clerk and an employee must be covered by a 1-38 surety bond on the same conditions [and in the same amount] as the district clerk.
