1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the recording of a criminal offense of transporting
 1-20 household goods without registration in a driving record.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 643.253, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-23 by adding Subsections (g) and (h) to read as follows:

1-24 (g) As soon as practicable after the date a person is
 1-25 convicted of an offense under Subsection (b), the convicting court
 1-26 shall notify the Department of Public Safety of the conviction. The
 1-27 notice must be in a form prescribed by the Department of Public
 1-28 Safety and must contain the person's driver's license number.

1-29 (h) A conviction under Subsection (b) shall be recorded in
 1-30 the person's driving record maintained by the Department of Public
 1-31 Safety.

1-32 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-33 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
 1-34 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
 1-35 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
 1-36 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
 1-37 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
 1-38 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
 1-39 committed before that date.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
