1-18 relating to designating March as Bleeding Disorders Awareness
 1-19 Month.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
 1-22 amended by adding Section 662.112 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 662.112. BLEEDING DISORDERS AWARENESS MONTH. (a)
 1-24 March is Bleeding Disorders Awareness Month to increase awareness
 1-25 of genetic disorders that prevent a person's blood from clotting
 1-26 properly and to encourage:

1-27 (1) research for treatments and cures of bleeding
 1-28 disorders; and
 1-29 (2) advocacy on behalf of persons with bleeding
 1-30 disorders.

1-31 (b) Bleeding Disorders Awareness Month may be regularly
 1-32 observed through appropriate activities in communities to increase
 1-33 awareness of bleeding disorders.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
