 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the imposition and rate of the county hotel occupancy
 1-23 tax in certain counties; authorizing the imposition of a tax.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 352.002, Tax Code, is amended by adding
 1-26 Subsection (z) to read as follows:

1-27 (z) The commissioners court of a county with a population of
 1-28 not more than 50,000 and in which an annual peanut festival is held
 1-29 may impose a tax as provided by Subsection (a).

1-30 SECTION 2. Section 352.003, Tax Code, is amended by adding
 1-31 Subsection (w) to read as follows:

1-32 (w) The tax rate in a county authorized to impose the tax
 1-33 under Section 352.002(z) may not exceed seven percent of the price
 1-34 paid for a room in a hotel, except that the tax rate may not exceed
 1-35 two percent of the price paid for a room in a hotel if the hotel is
 1-36 located in:

1-37 (1) a municipality that imposes a tax under Chapter
 1-38 351 applicable to the hotel; or

1-39 (2) the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a
 1-40 municipality that imposes a tax under Section 351.0025 applicable
 1-41 to the hotel.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
