 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 21 in
 1-20 Nacogdoches County as the Sergeant Tom Sitton Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.152 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.152. SERGEANT TOM SITTON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)
 1-25 The portion of State Highway 21 in Nacogdoches County between
 1-26 County Road 713 and County Road 782 is designated as the Sergeant
 1-27 Tom Sitton Memorial Highway.

1-28 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-29 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-30 designation as the Sergeant Tom Sitton Memorial Highway and any
 1-31 other appropriate information; and

1-32 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-33 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
