A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1-19 relating to the mandatory dismissal date of certain suits affecting 1-20 the parent-child relationship involving the Department of Family 1-21 and Protective Services. 1-22 1-23

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 263.401, Family Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b-2) to read as follows: 1-24

1-25 (b-2) When considering under Subsection (b) whether to find that extraordinary circumstances necessitate the child remaining in the temporary managing conservatorship of the department for a case in which the court orders a parent to complete a substance 1-26 1-27 1-28 abuse treatment program, the court shall consider whether the 1-29 1-30 parent made a good faith effort to successfully complete the 1-31 program.

SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 1-32 a suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A suit affecting the parent-child 1 - 331-34 1-35 relationship filed before that date is governed by the law in effect 1-36 on the date the suit was filed, and that law is continued in effect 1-37 for that purpose. 1-38
