AN ACT

- 2 relating to standards for nutrition, physical activity, and screen
- 3 time for certain child-care facilities and homes.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.042, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsections (e-3) and (e-4) to read as follows:
- 7 (e-3) The minimum standards adopted under Subsection (e)
- 8 must be consistent with:

- 9 (1) American Academy of Pediatrics standards for
- 10 physical activity and screen time as published in Caring for Our
- 11 Children: National Health and Safety Performance Standards;
- 12 Guidelines for Early Care and Education Programs, 3rd Edition; and
- 13 (2) the nutrition standards in the Child and Adult
- 14 Care Food Program administered by the Department of Agriculture.
- 15 (e-4) A licensed child-care facility or registered family
- 16 home is not required to participate in or comply with the reporting
- 17 requirements of the Child and Adult Care Food Program administered
- 18 by the Department of Agriculture.
- 19 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 20 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 21 Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to implement
- 22 the changes in law made by this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
