1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 67 in Titus  
 1-20 County as the Titus County World War II Veterans Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
 1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.152 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.152. TITUS COUNTY WORLD WAR II VETERANS MEMORIAL  
 1-25 HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of U.S. Highway 67 in Titus County  
 1-26 between its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 2348 and the  
 1-27 eastern municipal boundary of Mount Pleasant is designated as the  
 1-28 Titus County World War II Veterans Memorial Highway.

1-29 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-30 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
 1-31 designation as the Titus County World War II Veterans Memorial  
 1-32 Highway and any other appropriate information; and

1-33 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
 1-34 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
